Why make a request to the speaker's bureau?

The Alamo Wings speaker's bureau is composed of Airmen in the ranks of junior enlisted to field grade officers who volunteer their time to speak in the community. Most requests for speakers come from area schools and civic organizations. Our Speakers Bureau can be a valuable resource for your club or organization to learn more about Keesler and the people who perform our mission.

Speakers are available on a wide variety of subjects. Our speakers give comprehensive presentations and speeches about their respective career fields or extracurricular activities, speaking at schools, veteran and civic organizations, youth groups and others.

Our speakers provide this as a volunteer service. There is no charge or fee and honorariums are not accepted. However, we do ask that sponsoring organizations provide or reimburse speakers for any meals, travel and lodging expenses (government agencies provide per-diem and fund cite) if the engagement warrants it. Also, we ask sponsors to provide any audiovisual equipment, entrance or parking pass, map or detailed directions, etc., that the speaker may require.

Speakers are seldom available on short notice so we urge you to submit requests for speakers at least three weeks in advance.
